

Actual Impacts, Good, Bad and Ugly, of ELD Regulation Changes

PRESENTATION TOPICS & WHAT OUR SPEAKERS ARE SAYING...

A Regulatory 180 for Trucking "Are De-Regulatory Actions in Washington the New Normal for Trucking and Logistics?"

There is regulatory tug-of-war going on in Washington, and Washington insider Dave Osiecki will be with us again this year to cover what it means for the trucking and logistics industries. Mr. Osiecki will cover the Obama Administration rules (e.g., AOBRD conversion to ELDs, higher driver training bar, even tighter controls on drug & alcohol use) that still remain to be implemented that could reduce driver capacity even more. At the same time, Mr. Osiecki will explain what favorable regulatory changes and de-regulatory actions the Trump Administration has already taken, and what regulatory initiatives (e.g., hours of service changes) shippers, carriers and logistics providers should expect over the next two years.



Freight by Waterway Better Than a Highway

The Great Lakes Shuttle Service is a proposed service on the M-90 Marine Highway Route between the Port of Milwaukee and the Port of Muskegon. Eco Ships has partnered with the Port of Milwaukee to provide a service that will move commercial trucks, containers and break bulk cargos on a regular, fixed schedule. This would provide a dedicated commercial shipping route linking Wisconsin and West Michigan. In addition to the support of both State DOTs, Metropolitan Planning Organizations and other local stakeholders, this project will reduce congestion through the Chicago metro area as well as road maintenance costs and air emissions. More importantly, the service will provide shippers in the region a new, competitive, efficient, reliable alternative.
